Extend the Employee class to create a FullTimeEmployee class, with a monthlySalary attribute initialized through the constructor. Override the calculateSalary() method to calculate the final salary after deducting 5% tax from the monthly salary. 3. Instantiate the FullTimeEmployee class with an initial salary, and print the final salary after tax using the calculateSalary() method.	[Marks-10]	
c)	In a Product Inventory System, the system should allow an administrator to perform the following operations: Add New Product Records: > The system should allow the administrator to add new product records, including details such as the product's name, price, and product code. Update a Product Record: > The system should allow the administrator to update an existing product record in the database by providing the product's unique identifier (e.g., product code) and modifying details such as the name or price. Construct a PHP application using MySQL for database interaction to implement the Add and Update functionality that allows an administrator to: I. Add a new product record to the database. II.
