We collected data and designed an <u>algorithm</u> to improve automation in a smart monitoring system. After planning, we built a small <u>circiut</u> using sensors, <u>resistors</u>, and a <u>microcontrollor</u> device. The objective was to measure voltage and reduce energy loss caused by high <u>resistence</u>. All experimental results were stored in a secure <u>database</u>, connected through a <u>cloud</u> network. Each <u>senser</u> transmitted signals that were interpreted using logical functions and software tools. During <u>testing</u>, we <u>evaluated</u> system stability and checked whether mechanical forces reached <u>equilibriun</u>. The team applied principles of <u>thermodynemics</u> to control temperature fluctuation in the device. We also <u>experiminted</u> with a <u>nanoniateiral</u> coating to improve efficiency and durability. The code was compiled using a modern <u>compailer</u>, which helped <u>debug</u> several errors quickly. After multiple trials, the mechanism functioned <u>smoothly</u> under different load conditions.
