1.	Explain the functional steps of MIS and describe the purpose each step serves in managing an organization for competitive advantage.	[Marks-5]	CLO-1 Level-2
2.	Apex Footwear Limited, one of Bangladesh's largest shoe manufacturers and exporters, operates retail outlets across Dhaka, Chittagong, and Sylhet. At the retail counter: Sales staff scan the barcode at checkout. The system instantly records the product code, price, size, and time of sale, and updates inventory. If a customer asks "Do you have this shoe in size 42?", staff get an immediate yes/no answer from the same system. At the regional office: Every Monday, the Regional Sales Manager receives a report showing last week's total sales, top 5 best-selling models, and slow-moving inventory. Using this, the manager increases stock orders for top sellers and runs discounts on slow movers. At the head office: Apex's Board is deciding whether to open 15 new outlets over the next 3 years. Their system combines historical sales data, Bangladesh Bank interest rates, competitor data (Bata, Walkers), and BBS population data to model expected returns for different expansion plans.
