2. Assume a bank evaluates loan applications using a simple decision process. The program first [5] checks whether the applicant's monthly income is at least 40,000 taka; if it is, it then checks whether the applicant's credit score is 700 or above. Applicants who meet both requirements are approved for the loan, while others are rejected with the appropriate reason. You are required to draw a flowchart representing this decision-making process in a clear and organized manner.
3. Assume Mr. Kakon has 8,753 taka in his bank account. When he enters a withdrawal amount, [5] the program first checks whether the requested amount exceeds the available balance. If it does, an "Insufficient Balance" message is displayed. If the amount is within the available funds, the program then checks whether the amount is a valid multiple of 500. If this condition is not met, an "Invalid Denomination" message is shown. Only when both conditions are satisfied does the program approve the withdrawal and complete the transaction.
