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(a)	Implement a network using OSPF (Open Shortest Path First) to connect six different networks with the following network addresses: • 193.168.10.0/24 • 193.168.20.0/24 • 193.168.30.0/24 • 193.168.40.0/24 • 193.168.50.0/24 • 193.168.60.0/24 Additionally, configure DHCP in one router so that end devices connected to the router automatically receive their IP addresses.
