1.	A bank wants to create a system to decide whether a customer can get a loan. First, the system checks the customer's monthly salary. If the salary is 30,000 taka or more, then it checks the credit score. -If the credit score is 700 or above, the loan is approved. -If the credit score is below 700, the loan is conditionally approved (with extra requirements). If the salary is less than 30,000 taka, the loan is rejected immediately (no need to check credit score). Finally, the system shows the decision to the customer. I. Write an algorithm for the above problem. II. Draw a flowchart for the above problem.	[5+5]	CO2
2.	a) A company's network is being observed by two hackers: Hacker A quietly monitors the network traffic, scans for open ports, and collects information about devices and services but does not change anything. Hacker B intercepts messages, modifies transaction data, and sends fake instructions to the network devices, affecting their normal operation. Classify the attacks of Hacker A and Hacker B as passive or active, and compare active and passive attacks by providing at least three differences between them.	[1+3]	CO3
	b) A student in Dhaka uses a mobile banking app (such as bKash) to send money and pay bills. One day, he connects to a free public Wi-Fi network at a cafe. An attacker on the same network secretly captures his login credentials and later uses them to access his account and view his personal and financial information. The attacker then changes transaction details and transfers money to another account. After some time, the mobile banking service becomes unavailable for several hours due to a system attack, and the student is unable to access his account.	[3+3]
