Case study: You have been appointed as the **Project Manager** of a software company that has won a government-funded project to develop a **Smart Agriculture Management System** for farmers across Bangladesh. The objective is to improve agricultural productivity by integrating IoT sensors, weather forecasting and crop disease detection using AI, fertilizer recommendations, online market access and financial support services.

The project duration is 5 months, with a fixed budget and strict delivery deadline because the system must be operational before the next planting season. Any delay may significantly affect thousands of farmers.

Your project team consists of 10 software developers, 2 AI engineers, 2 IoT engineers, 2 QA engineers, 1 database administrator and 4 support staff. Although the technical team has good programming skills, they have little experience working with IoT devices deployed in rural areas.

The client includes the Ministry of Agriculture, while other stakeholders include local farmers, agricultural officers, mobile network operators, banks providing loans, IT product suppliers, and local government authorities.
