2.	A national Environmental Protection Authority operates an integrated information system to monitor and manage environmental pollution across the country. The authority oversees multiple Regions and each Region contains several Monitoring Zones. Within each Monitoring Zone, multiple Sensor Stations are installed to collect environmental data such as air quality, water quality, noise levels, and temperature at regular time intervals. Each Sensor Station is equipped with multiple Sensors, where each Sensor measures a specific environmental parameter. Sensor readings are time-stamped and must be stored historically for trend analysis. Environmental Inspection Teams are assigned to Monitoring Zones and may conduct field inspections that result in inspection reports. Industries located within Monitoring Zones are required to comply with environmental regulations, and violations may be recorded against an industry based on sensor data or inspection findings. Regulatory actions such as warnings, fines, or shutdown orders may be issued, and the system must maintain a complete history of violations, inspections, and enforcement actions for legal and policy analysis. Draw a complete ER diagram for the system. Include: • entities, attributes (mark key attributes), • relationship types, • cardinality and participation constraints, • any weak entity (if applicable).
