After leaving the website and revisiting it two weeks later, the customer finds that all previously selected products are still present in the cart. Illustrate the step-by-step transaction mechanism between the browser and the shopping website server that allowed the platform to identify how this functionality is possible despite HTTP being a stateless protocol. Explain the role of cookies in maintaining user-specific information.	[Marks-5]	
2.	a)	DIU's student portal handles a "Course Drop" request. When an authorized student clicks the "Drop Course" button on their screen, the system must process this command; it captures the click, evaluates if the request falls within the allowed academic calendar deadline, runs a command to check and delete the enrollment record in the persistent storage, and finally redraws the updated class schedule table showing the course successfully removed. Classify which exact component (Model, View, or Controller) is responsible for each of the task mentioned above in the scenario and explain the whole Course Drop request process through the MVC lifecycle.
