3.	In Flutter, Michael Scott from Dunder Mifflin wants to create a mobile app feature that displays his "World's Best Boss" mug. The mug starts small and pulsates on the screen:		[10]	CO4

	- The mug container starts with width = 50 and height = 50 - Expands smoothly to width = 150 and height = 150 over 3 seconds - Then shrinks back to 50×50 over the next 3 seconds - This animation repeats continuously (expand and shrink forever) - The container should be coffee brown color and centered on the screen - Inside the container, display the text "World's Best Boss" in white color and bold - The app should have an AppBar with title "Michael's Mug" Analyze the animation requirements, implement the complete Flutter code, and clearly explain how each major part of your code (e.g., widget type, animation controller, tween, repeat logic, etc.) contributes to achieving the required behavior.		
4.	a) In The Office, Dwight Schrute is hoarding beetroot jars in his desk. He starts with 10 jars on day 1. Each day he follows a strange rule: - If the number of jars is even, he gives away half of them to Jim (as a prank revenge). - If the number of jars is odd, he steals 5 more jars from the office kitchen. Write a function beetJars(int days) that returns the number of jars Dwight has after the given number of days, starting from day 1 applying the rule repeatedly.
