departments(department_id, department_name)

project_assignments(emp_id, project_id)

5. Find employees whose salary is above the average salary of their department. (4)

employees(emp_id, name, department_id, manager_id, salary)

departments(department_id, department_name)

salaries(emp_id, salary, effective_date)
