2.	You are asked for designing an Online Food Delivery System . The system consists of three core entities: <u>Customer</u> , <u>Restaurant</u> , and <u>Order</u> . Analyze the relationships among these entities and determine the appropriate association types and multiplicities. 3.	You are tasked to develop a simple Arithmetic Calculator in Java that can perform addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division. To make your program robust and maintainable, you must follow the below guidelines. 1. Create a class named Calculator with private instance variables to store two numbers (num1 and num2). 2. Apply the encapsulation concept to access and modify these numbers. 3. Implement the following public methods in the class: add() → returns the sum of the two numbers, subtract() → returns the difference, multiply() → returns the product, divide() → returns the quotient, but should handle division by zero using exception handling to avoid the exception. 4. Declare the main method in another class named User which has association relation with Calculator class and from the main method, set the values, and display results of all operations.	12	CO4
