Analyze how Rafi can develop better communication awareness to manage impressions in both professional and peer settings. During mock interviews, he also struggles to maintain steady eye contact, and his hand gestures become exaggerated when he tries to emphasize his points. These habits occasionally make him appear uncertain or unfocused, despite his strong qualifications. Interpret how Rafiq can refine his verbal clarity, pacing, and tone to demonstrate composure and leadership authority during the interview.
