His cousin owns a computer shop and asks for the contract. However, Mahi sets aside his personal relationship and evaluates all vendors based solely on price and performance to ensure the hospital gets the best deal. • A programming bug lets the hospital charge insurance companies a bit more than what's legally permitted.
